In terms of deep hole drilling this equates to a surface finish of 0.8  $\mu$ m/32 CLA and a total runout (TIR) of 0.025.

Following the recent commissioning of two Sunnen horizontal tube honing machines ideally suited to applications requiring high stock removal rates on larger diameter components, BS EN ISO 9001:2008/BS EN 9100:2009-accredited Hone-All has now installed a long bed gundrill and an additional small CNC lathe. In addition to this, the Hone-All team is looking forward to the delivery of a new Tuscan LC38 4150 mm between centres CNC lathe with a 230 mm bore
