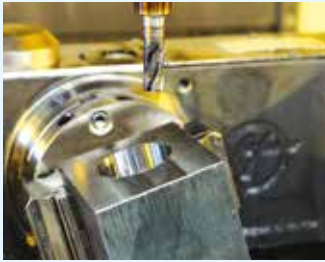

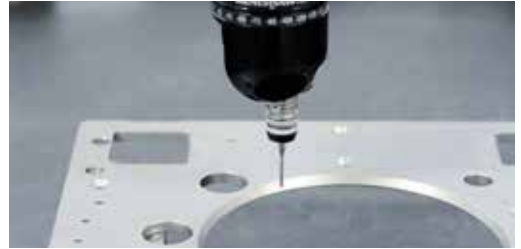
Finishing the job
