...the quality promise

Homestead quarantee these quality specifications to bring you a strong and durable building for year round use based on 30 years experience in manufacturing timber buildings:

1 Floor

The solid timber floor, made from 22mm thick interlocked boards on 50 x 75mm floor joists, will support the weight of a car - no creaking, no sagging!

2 Frame:

The basic skeleton is made from strong 50 x 75mm framing with studs and uprights at close centres to maintain a rigid construction.



All external timber is painted with two coats of external paint or wood stain in a colour of your choice.

3 Cladding & Insulation:

High quality cladding board prevents weather penetration. No gaps or draughts. An internal damp membrane ensures a moisture resistant and draught free superstructure.

All wall and ceiling cavities are compacted with heat insulation and internally lined with vertical pine boards throughout. The pine walls are left natural and can be colour. washed if preferred.

4 Windows & Doors:

We incorporate British Standard house quality double-glazed windows and doors. The window units are 1.2m wide x 1.08m deep and the doors are half-glazed and complete with locks, handles and draught excluders.

5 Roof:

There are two types of roof tile available, dependent on your personal preference:

1. Asphalt tiles

Lightweight but incredibly strong, as used extensively on housing in America These are included in the standard price and carry a 25 year quarantee.

2. Cedar Shingles

These traditional timber tiles (as photo) make an attractive feature of the roof. Available at an extra cost to the standard specification. (See Price List).



From planning...

Planning permission will be required for garden buildings in conservation areas, listed buildings and areas of outstanding natural beauty.

The latest planning law also requires that garden buildings will need planning permission if any part of the roof over 2.5m (8'6") high falls within 2m (6'6") of a boundary.





As most pitched (apex roof) buildings are 3-3.5m high this rule will apply unless 2m can be left from your boundary fences.

However in our experience of submitting over a hundred planning permission applications a year we have found that this is only a formality and it is extremely rare for garden buildings irrespective of their use to be refused

We can also obtain planning permission retrospectively in most cases.

At our *FREE* site survey we will determine the planning criteria for your property and advise you accordingly.

If planning permission is required our free planning service initiates us as your agent where we will fill in and submit all the necessary forms, architectural and location plans and pay the £150 fee *FREE* of charge on your behalf.

Planning permission normally takes 8 weeks to obtain and we will book the work in to our manufacturing schedule to coincide with the expected planning grant time.

Planning permission can be avoided if:

1) 2m can be left from all boundaries in the case of a pitched (apex) roof.

2) Your building is made with a flat roof under 2.5m high which is possible with any of our designs (see the 'Oxford' building page 20).

- ✓ We will liaise and meet (if necessary) with your local council to get the application approved.
- ✓ We enter your building. into our work programme to conform with the expected planning approval (8/10 weeks).
- ✓ We pay all planning application and drawing fees

This building is ideal as a garden office, enabling you to work from home in an airv spacious environment.

The height of the eaves and ridge make a pleasant non-claustrophobic environment without spoiling the discreet low profile of the building.

The Windsor has a traditional design with an increased roof pitch.

The veranda size is optional but will need to be 1.2 metres deep to comfortably seat a sun chair so you can enjoy your garden all Summer long!

Veranda handrails and spindles are included which can be turned or straight.



Every 'Windsor' building includes construction of a concrete base plus full electrical installation and connection to the house supply.

Standard Features:

- 2.25m (7'6") eaves headroom, 3.3m (10'6") ridge height
- optional depth veranda canopy
- half-glazed double doors (double-glazed)
- any amount of 1.2 metre wide double-glazed windows fitted where you specify
- fully insulated and pine lined internally


The Oxford has been designed with a flat roof under 2.5 metres high.

With current planning legislation this means it can go within 2 metres of a boundary **without** the need for planning permission.

The Oxford has a modern

contemporary appearance and the low profile to the roof makes the building inconspicuous.

▼ This 'Oxford' is 4.2m (14') wide. The external wall colour is Dune Grass.



- any amount of 60cm wide double-glazed windows fitted where you specify
- a pair of double-glazed doors
- optional integral porch
- 60cm (2') canopy overhang with downlighters

The Richmond has a minimalistic style with a light, airy and spacious feel.

The deep windows keep vou connected with the garden and the veranda gives you a cool, dry external sitting area. The decking area at the front can be extended to give more outside leisure space.



■ This 'Richmond' is 6m x 6m (20' x 20'). The external cladding is stained with an oak colour preservative and the roof shows cedar shingles.





Every 'Richmond' building includes construction of a concrete base plus full electrical installation and connection to the house supply.

Standard Features:

- · full length double-glazed windows and doors
- exterior cladding painted or stained in your choice of colour
- · interior fully insulated and lined
- veranda canopy overhang
- chunky veranda posts

▲ This 'Richmond' is 4.8m x 4.8m (16' x 16'). The external cladding is Cloverleaf and the roof shows cedar shingles.

Our prices include the provision of a level and firm concrete base foundation and complete electrical installation and connection to your house supply via armoured cable.



Accurate basework

As the longevity and efficiency of your garden room depends on an accurate and level base, we lay a thick concrete pad, dead square with no undulations or falls. The base will be made to the exact same length and depth as the building ordered.

The base will be above ground to avoid the ingress of pooling water underneath the timber floor

Our basework team will liaise on site to ensure that your base is provided in your exact desired location.

Reliable electrics

All our garden rooms come complete with the necessary electrical components.

The positioning of all electrical sockets, switches, lights and heater is optional and will be installed to your preferred positions.

Please note: We do not install elevated 'jack' style supports which allow rats, mice, foxes and badgers to nest beneath the building!

Our standard installation includes:

- 1. A consumer unit (fuseboard), complete with trip switches for maximum safety.
- 2. A double plug socket on each wall, which is eight plug points in total.
- 3. Two tracks of double spotlights creating direct or reflective light to your required areas.
- 4. A light switch.

- 5. A panel/convector heater complete with:
- (a) A thermostat so you can regulate your preferred temperature.
- (b) A timer so that you can set your specific on and off times to your working requirements.
- (c) A booster fan for a fast warm up in extreme cold weather.
- 6. A safety certificate on completion.

White colour wash for timber lined rooms (see internal photo of 'Windsor' P13). White emulsion for plasterboard (see internal photo of 'Oxford' P20).

External timber colours

Prior to delivery we apply two coats of highly durable paint or wood stain to all external timber and window/door frames.

Choose from these exciting colours:

All the colours shown are to be used as a guideline only. The colours have been reproduced as close as the printing processes will allow. Actual samples can be submitted if required.

Roof Tiles

Extensively used on housing in America, asphalt tiles are the standard roof finish on all of our buildings.

Due to their high strength, thick granule

protection and preimpregnated construction, their guaranteed life span is 25 years.

Available in red, brown or black that will not fade





Cedar Shingles

These are an optional extra suitable for all our buildings.

These timber tiles have a rich warm colour and texture giving a touch of individuality that blends well with any environment. The extrathickness of timber on the roof will increase the buildings thermal properties. A 25 year life expectancy.
