Routine daily cleansing with:

TAMODINE combines tamed iodine with a detergent to produce an antiseptic which gently cleans wounds and skin.

TAMODINE-E suitable for thorough disinfection of the incubator and brooder between batches.



Introduction



Tortoises

VITAMINS & MINERALS

Our recommendation for chelonia in general is the routine use of **NUTROBAL** daily for the first couple of years of life, then as they become closer to adult size and growth slows **ARKVITS** are suitable.

The correct diet is especially crucial to avoid lumpy shell in hatchlings.

Periodic use of **ACE-HIGH** is also well worthwhile, especially during poor summers when natural vitamin A levels are low. Vitamin A deficiency is a common problem in captive tortoises and terrapins. It has been linked with infortility. Purply Name Syndrome, excellent

infertility, Runny Nose Syndrome, swollen eyes and kidney diseases.

Insect eaters

GRUB GRUB and BUG GRUB

Our two foods designed for feeding to mealworm-type grubs and cricket-type bugs to both keep them healthy but ALSO to improve their dietary value by BOOSTING their calcium and protein levels. This can be used in addition to NUTROBAL dusting powder.

Frogs and toads are easily supplemented using crickets dusted this way with NUTROBAL. Periodic use of ACE-

The vitamin A content is particularly important for the larger lizards which, in addition to calcium for bone growth, seem to require higher levels of vitamin A than snakes. It is clear that reptiles benefit from extra vitamin A when sloughing or if they have been diseased,

BSP vitamin drops (high potency liquid multivitamin with no sugary carriers) have been found to be very useful for supplementing small snakes such as garter snakes and many of the smaller lizards and chameleons which can be difficult to supplement in other ways.

ZOLCAL D a palatable liquid calcium and vitamin D product to sprinkle onto greenfood for suspicious feeders or to add to water or even direct dose. This can prove very useful for use with slow feeding amphibia.

REPTOBOOST is ideal to be put in the water for convalescent or old or slow feeding reptiles.

Veterinary and 'First Aid'

REPTOBOOST is a probiotic, maltodextrin glucose and electrolyte mixture ideal for the rehydration of reptiles especially tortoises when they first wake from hibernation, or as a support therapy when they are under veterinary treatment. This can be given by tube in reptiles or can be used in the drinking water. Newly purchased animals may be dehydrated or seriously stressed and in need of special attention.

CRITICAL CARE FORMULA (CCF) is a powder which can be mixed with water to provide a high energy and amino acid fluid which can be given by tube or via drinking water. This has proved extremely effective in supporting sick animals while they are too weak to feed. CCF is not a treatment, it is the nutritional support *par excellance*.

mouthrot lesions, wounds or ulcers from 'blister disease' etc, as a support to veterinary treatment.

ARK-KLENS, is very useful as a 'wipe' for terrapins, its anti-algal properties will help clear this from the shell. It can be used as a freshly made up 0.1% solution (1ml/litre) to wipe the eyes and as an aid to shedding in snakes which can be wiped down with the solution. Make the solution up freshly each time to avoid the risk of build up of harmful
